- Operations in 13 countries







Which means:

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









Revenue per industry January - December 2011

Key market developments

- Datacenter virtualization and automation no 1 on CIO agenda
- Storage market growing at 8.5% in 2012 (more than twice as fast as the overall IT market) according to IDC and Gartner
- Private cloud adoption in the datacenter takes off fueled by infrastructure virtualization
- Trusted local cloud providers manages the risk factors in the cloud
- Big data drives scale out NAS growth
- Performance requirements and power reductions gives solid state storage (SSD) a strong foothold in the datacenter
- Storage efficiency technologies offset server virtualization drawbacks using deduplication, tiering and thin provisioning
- The movement of critical applications to the virtual infrastructure emphasize the need for solid data protection and disaster recovery solutions








Storage market 4 year forecast, source: IDC/SNIA










